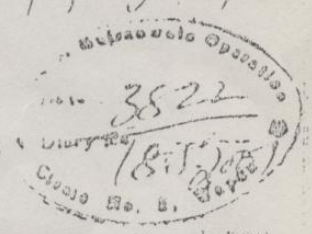

Subject: Recovery of Cost from consumers on Account of Stolen Material

Decision  
S.M.S

Refer Tel conversation with Chairman WAPDA dated 18.4.2001.

1. Due to wide spread area, instances of conductor and Transformer theft keep on occurring at a pace which is a cause of concern, apart from financial loss to WAPDA. In 1998-99, financial loss on account of theft alone was Rs. 1576975.00.

To arrest the trend, a system of cost sharing of stolen material by WAPDA and consumer was initiated. In face of natural consumer resistance, the implementation was done gradually. The advantage gained is that, during year 1999-2000, material theft worth was Rs 1306542.00 and 2000-2001 Rs 3,38,551 up to Mar 2001.

Recently in one such case a consumer filed a writ petition in the High Court against the Stolen Material Cost Recovery being done by WAPDA. The Honourable court after going through the merits of the case gave the following decision:-

Send copies to all WAPDA WOT be

- a. Cost of stolen material will be recovered from all consumers, equally distributing upon them
- b. Recovery will be in three equal monthly installments.
- c. Recovery will be in monthly future bills.
- d. WAPDA to restore electricity at once.

Copy of High Court Multan Bench judgment is attached for perusal as Annex B and newspaper coverage as Annex C.

The above decision is very favourable and if referred to judiciously will keep the losses on Stolen Material losses to the minimum.

Arguments have also been heard on the main writ petition.
- The S.R.O. has submitted that WAPDA will provide the cable the cost of which will be Rs. 50000/- and will recover that cost from all the consumers equally distributing upon them which will come to Rs. 700/- per consumer in three equal instalments that will come to Rs. 239.33 per month which will be taken from each consumer in monthly future bills. The petitioner has accepted this offer. Accordingly the writ petition is disposed of on the above terms.
- The SDO ensures that the electricity connection will be restored till 29.4.2001. Compliance report shall be sent to this Court through Addl. Registrar of this Court.
