Subject: Wrong Charging of Maximum Demand Indicator (MDI) by DISCOs to the Consumers

Your attention is drawn to explanation issued vide NEPRA's letter No. NEPRA/R/LAD-11/12890 dated 19th November, 2013. The response submitted by IESCO vide letter No. 17255/CEO/IESCO/CSD dated 06th December, 2013 was considered by the Authority in its regulatory meeting dated 15th January, 2014 and the Authority has decided as follows:

“..... to close the matter and instructed to issue the directions to all DISCOs for strict observance of the terms and conditions regarding the approved tariff and apply only one MDI reading per month for billing of Time of Use (TOU) consumers forthwith to save the DISCOs from further financial loss. For this purpose, if any modification is required, the same shall be carried out immediately to facilitate the recording of single MDI and billing accordingly.”

2. The above directions of the Authority are hereby conveyed to IESCO for strict compliance. A report to this effect shall be submitted by 31st March, 2014 for presentation to the Authority.
